at Spaxton Village Hall



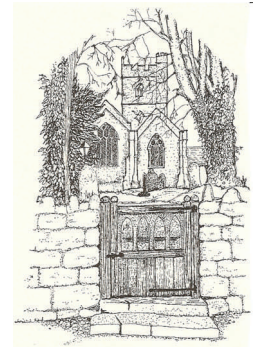
